THE PLAINS OF ABRAHAM, QUEBEC CITY

The first national historic park in Canada, The Battlefields Park, also known as the Plains of Abraham, is the site of clashes between the British and French armies when the fate of the Americas was played out. The park is in the heart of Québec City, designated a World Heritage treasure by UNESCO and only walled city north of Mexico. It is one of the largest and most attractive urban parks in the world, just as Central Park and Hyde Park.

Attended by 4 million visitors annually (1,000,000 came in groups over the years), discover what the park has to offer: exciting exhibitions and activities available year-round for all visitors and around 50 activities for groups (adults and youth).

For example, immerse yourself into the Seven Years' War with Battles 1759-1760 with an interactive and moving exhibition, or put on traditional snowshoes to follow "The Snowshoer," for an authentic guided tour on the snowy Plains.







Founded in 1881, Val Notre-Dame Abbey, previously in Oka, has 20 monks who pray 7 times a day in the chapel of the monastery. Anyone can participate in these times of prayer, the guests who stay in the hotel as well as visitors passing by. The monks support themselves by offering various products in their store or online: chocolates, nut butter, caramels, cakes and edible forest products. The store offers a wide range of local Lanaudière products and religious items. A room inside the gift shop hosts exhibitions in the summer and turns into a cross-country ski centre in the winter. Information sessions about forest products and cooking classes take place in the store area.

The Our Lady of the Cape Shrine is the third largest Marian Shrine in North America. Founded in 1888, the Shrine attracts more than 430,000 visitors yearly. Basilique-cathédrale de la paroisse de Notre-Dame-de-Québec

Welcome to Quebec City's Notre-Dame Cathedral, the official home of the oldest Catholic diocese from North America to northern Mexico. This is where the first mission chapel of New France was erected in 1647, followed by the first parish church of New France, in 1664. This church was then turned into a cathedral in 1674, before being expanded and altered by several generations of architects. It remains a model of religious architecture. Bombarded during the siege of Quebec in 1759, the cathedral was rebuilt fairly accurately over a five-year period from 1766 to 1771. In 1843 it was equipped with an impressive neoclassical façade, which elevated this cathedral to the rank of a basilica in 1874. Ravaged by a fire in 1922, it was, again, almost entirely rebuilt. Keeping its monumental appearance in the mid-19th century, it was proclaimed Canada's primatial cathedral in 1956. Eventually, it was given the title of primatial church, as it is the mother church of the first Catholic diocese in Canada.
