Opening of the Holy Door – Québec city - ecdq.org

From December 8, 2023, to December 8, 2024. To celebrate its Diocesan Jubilee (350th anniversary) and the history of the Faith in America, the Notre-Dame de Québec Basilica-Cathedral opens its Holy Door.

The Holy Door is an actual door located in the wall of the Sacred Heart Chapel of the Basilica-Cathedral of Notre-Dame de Québec on the cathedral's north side. Having one is an exceptional privilege authorized by the Holy See. The Holy Door of Quebec was inaugurated in 2013 on the 350th anniversary of the founding of Notre-Dame de Québec parish, the first parish in North America, north of the Spanish colonies of those days. There are only 7 in the world. 6 are in Europe:

1. Basilica of Santa Maria in Collemaggio.
2. Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore
3. Basilica of St. John Lateran
4. Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls
5. Basilica of St. Peter
6. Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela

The Holy Door of the Basilica-Cathedral of Quebec is the only one outside Europe. People from all walks of life who pass through a Holy Door do so as a spiritual itinerary. The Holy Door is linked to the pilgrimage experience, a symbol of human life, of the earthly passage towards a horizon of eternity, during which one encounters God on one's life journey. The Door symbolizes Jesus Christ, who said: "I am the Door. No one goes to the Father without passing through me."

Exploring this fascinating part of history will also shed light on our society through the ages, values and good manners, relations between women and men, and cultural influences from elsewhere. It will also be an opportunity to highlight the contribution of the Congrégation de Notre Dame in teaching cooking to generations of Quebecers and the prominent place of the nuns' flagship work, [La cuisine raisonnée](#), whose 100th anniversary was celebrated in 2019.

Noah's Ark - From May 25, 2023, to March 17, 2024. The Historic Site Marguerite Bourgeoys addresses this theme through the paper sculptures created by Claude Lafortune, which tell this famous myth in their way.

Bonsecours Neighbourhood – walking tour in Old Montreal to learn about the history of Montreal.

Nuns, Teachers, and Scientists! - From May 4, 2023, to April 7, 2024. The exhibition also presents the winding path that led women to be able to study and work in science, with limited options for them until the 1960s. Broadcast in the exhibition is the testimonies of contemporary scientists.

Themed Tours in Montréal & Suburbs

Montreal's first and only hospital until 1822, Hôtel-Dieu, was founded by Jeanne Mance and then administered by the Hospitalières de Saint-Joseph, who came to help in 1659. It offers groups some thematic tours highlighting the heritage site of the

conventual complex of the Hospitalières de l'Hôtel-Dieu de Montréal.

Painters: The tradition of great painted decors in Montreal: from John Held to Napoleon Bourassa - Victor Bourgeau, Guido Nincheri and Ozias.

Crypt and the Chapel: Enter the Chapel of the Hospitallers in the heart of the Plateau Mont-Royal, and enter the crypt where more than 600 Hospitallers and Jeanne Mance, co-founder of Montreal, are buried.

Our mountain Memories of Mount Royal: Produced on the occasion of the bicentennial of the birth of the designer of Mount Royal Park, American landscape architect Frederick Law Olmsted (1822-1903), this temporary exhibition focuses on the significant issues that have marked the development and preservation of the mountain.

Religious Heritage: Let Montreal's religious heritage amaze you on off-wall tours, and discover unsuspected architectural and artistic treasures!

Garden: A true oasis of peace and greenery, hidden behind the stone walls of the monastery, the Hospitallers' garden is a must-see during the summer!

Organ recitals: A series of concerts showcasing some of our Montreal churches' finest instruments. Demonstrating the organ stops precedes the recitals so you can appreciate each instrument's quality.

Stella Nivis: Starting in the spring of 2024, a presentation that immerses us in an immersive universe oscillating between mystery and realism. A mix of historical, patrimonial, and architectural elements intermingled with fables and fantasy, allowing us to live a moment of incredible beauty and wonder accessible to the whole family. (Animation without spoken text, but a brief printed introduction is available in several languages).

Five places to discover from the Mohawk community to the first Canadian-born saint village. In 2023, Les Sanctuaires du Fleuve will add two other attractions and a series of unique itineraries:

The church of La-Nativité-de-la-Sainte-Vierge: Built in 1840-1841. Built during the significant economic boom that La Prairie experienced thanks to the construction of the first railroad in Canada, it was considered the most important rural church in the Montreal diocese at its inauguration.

A guided tour of this church can be complemented by a visit to the **Musée archéologique du Roussillon** near this sanctuary. It showcases the rich heritage of the 11 towns in the region. Discover over 5,000 years of history through more than 200,000 artifacts from the area. It is possible to visit the reserve. Upon reservation for a minimum of 10 people, an archaeologist will be pleased to welcome visitors and answer their questions.

Five new itineraries:

Discover places rich in cultural treasures: This tour offers a clever mix of architecture and priceless works of art and paintings by Guido Nincheri on the site of the birthplace of Marguerite d'Youville, Canada's first "saint. *historical heritage - artworks - paintings - gardens – architecture*

Discover the richness of our cultural and architectural heritage: Immerse yourself in the history of larger-than-life characters who forged Quebec's history. Admire the architecture of the Saint-Antoine-de-Padoue Co-Cathedral, impressive with its 85-meter high bell tower, the carved wooden pulpit with its abat-voix staircase and statues made in 1865, a priceless work of art at the La Nativité Church and the 18th-century buildings of the SNJM site. *historical figures - cultural heritage - artworks - native artifacts - heritage – architecture*

Get off the beaten track: A tour to discover the aboriginal, historical and natural heritage by visiting the Manoir d'Youville site combined with a wildlife reserve on the shores of Lake Saint-Louis and the sanctuary dedicated to the first aboriginal "saint": Kateri Tekakwitha. *historical figures - cultural heritage - gardens - wildlife refuge - native artifacts – heritage*

Immerse yourself in the rich heritage of the Saint Lawrence River Shrines: Take advantage of this tour to discover the secrets of seven places that are not to be missed, both because of their history and because of the remarkable works of craftsmen and great artists, such as Guido Nincheri, from Varennes to Châteauguay along the St. Lawrence River. *historical figures - cultural heritage - gardens - wildlife refuge - native artifacts - heritage - artworks - paintings - history – architecture*

See what the Saint Lawrence River Shrines offer: A visit that will show you the well-preserved heritage of the past, the stories of daring women and men and the exceptional cultural and artistic treasures from Châteauguay to Varennes, south of the St. Lawrence River. *historical figures - cultural heritage - gardens - wildlife refuge - native artifacts - heritage - artworks - paintings - history - architecture*

And these visits can be complemented with a stay at Manoir D'Youville.

Hotel Manoir D'Youville - manoirdyouville.ca

Located on Île Saint-Bernard in Châteauguay, 40 minutes from downtown Montréal, on the shores of the Châteauguay River and Lac Saint-Louis, Manoir D'Youville is an exceptional resort that boasts a 114-room hotel and eight meeting rooms, located in a lush, tranquil setting where nature meets culture.

The important historical past of Saint Bernard Island makes its unique mark. As the cradle of the Châteauguay seigneurie, heritage vestiges adorn the square and contribute to the beauty of the place. During your visit, you will have the chance to admire one of the oldest mills in North America, dating back to 1686.

Monasteriorum Pilgrim Road – monasteriorum.com





The Monasteriorum Pilgrimage Trail is a 28-kilometre walking trail located north of Lac-Saint-Jean, between Dolbeau-Mistassini and Saint-Eugène-d'Argentenay.

In an environment conducive to meditation, slow down time by walking in the footsteps of the Cistercian monks of Mistassini and discover the three sites where the Trappist Fathers established their monasteries in 1892.

In contact with an exceptional natural heritage, pastoral peace leads walkers and pilgrims through the fields while following the magnificent Rat River.
